Dear Senior Parents/Guardians,

The 2018 – 2019 Apollo-Ridge High School yearbook, the *Valhalla*, is already underway, and the yearbook staff is excited to be working on this annual! This letter is to notify you of important information about your student's senior yearbook!

1. FORMAL SENIOR PORTRAIT

The formal yearbook portrait must be taken by LifeTouch Studios. We have worked with LifeTouch to provide a specific background and image size for the yearbook. Your son/daughter must have

their picture taken **Thursday, September 27th**

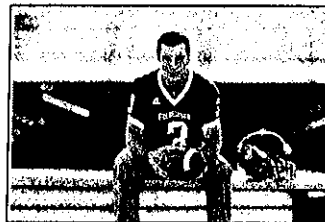
for it to be included in the Yearbook. Attire: Students are encouraged to dress professionally – i.e. boys are encouraged to wear a suit jacket, shirt, and tie; girls are encouraged to wear solid colored blouses, sweaters, etc. All dress code rules must be followed (i.e. no sleeveless shirts). Once your picture is taken, LifeTouch will send your proofs to your house for your review. You will have the opportunity to choose which picture you would like to use for the formal senior portrait. You can also purchase those pictures, but you are not obligated to do so.

* Note: Seniors will also have their picture taken on the Underclassmen picture Day (September 19th) for their student ID.



2. INFORMAL SENIOR PICTURES

The yearbook staff will also ask Seniors to submit several items for the senior section of the *Valhalla*. Seniors will have the opportunity to submit informal pictures taken by other photographers. For example, a student may have a picture taken outside, during a sporting event, or in a less formal pose. These may be submitted several ways. 1. they can be given to the Yearbook Adviser Mrs. Guido in room B112. The picture will be scanned and then returned to the student. 2. the picture can be sent electronically by emailing it to aguido@apolloridge.com. 3. they can be saved on a USB drive or CD and given to Mrs. Guido.
